Our plan for the plan

In order to know what to focus on as a new organisation, we're adopting the following process.

Element	Current Status (as at Feb 2020)
1. Scope : Actively listening, understanding what's important to people, to create a long list of ideas/insights. You might call this the wide end of the funnel, capturing everything.	We've started this and will continue to capture ideas at the Litter Pick and Ideas Walk on 28th March 2020 10-11am. (Meet outside the Cruising Club).
2. Structure: Organising your ideas into themes.	We have identified four key themes in what we've already heard. These are:
	 Maintenance & repair Projects & investments Community, consultation, relationships & events Wildlife protection.
	As we're still in listening mode, these might still shift as we gather more insights.
3. <i>Prioritisation</i> : Choosing the activities to focus on that give us the greatest return.	From a long-term planning perspective we're early days on prioritising, but, we do not want to rest on our laurels, so we have chosen to initially focus on both the Litter Pick and the Suffrage Sensory Garden whilst we more thoroughly go through this bigger consultation and planning process. We believe this will keep our momentum up and we've chosen projects that align to the key themes we've already identified so far.
<i>4. Resources: Securing the time, skills and money we need to deliver our priorities.</i>	We're yet to develop our long-term approach for partnerships, membership/volunteers and fundraising, but we're working on it.
	In the meantime, the Litter Pick is organised, some funds have already been raised for the Suffrage Sensory Garden, and we're already getting more people on-board to donate their time and skills to help with the project.
5. Delivery: Execution of the chosen activities.	Status: Litter Pick/Ideas Walk organised; Suffrage Sensory Garden project plan in development.
